## **SHASTA COUNTY FIRE RELIEF FUND**

### **Grant Allocation Process**

*United Way of Northern California, in partnership with Tri Counties Bank, will distribute grants to households that have suffered losses due to the Carr Fire.*

*These grants are intended for emergency cash assistance to help with immediate cash needs. They are not intended to replace regular income or to address major repairs or replacement of homes.*

*The amount per grant and the number of people served are dependent on the results of United Way's fundraising efforts.*

*Decisions on grant awards will be made by a committee consisting of representatives of Tri Counties Bank, United Way and the community. We cannot guarantee that everyone who suffered loss will receive a grant. Final decisions on grant awards and awardees are solely at the discretion of United Way of Northern California.*

- 1. Applications will be available beginning Thursday, Aug. 2 and can be accessed through the UWNC website, [www.norcalunitedway.org](http://www.norcalunitedway.org).**
- 2. United Way will begin receiving applications Aug. 2. The deadline to submit applications will be four weeks after official containment of the Carr Fire.**
- 3. Applications will be accepted by mail, in person, fax or email scan.**

5. Applications will be reviewed on an ongoing basis by a community panel.
6. Notification of decisions will be made as soon as possible. We will strive for notifications no more than seven days after receipt of an application.
7. Grant Recipients will be told where and when to collect their checks. If they cannot travel to pick up the check, alternative arrangements will be made.
